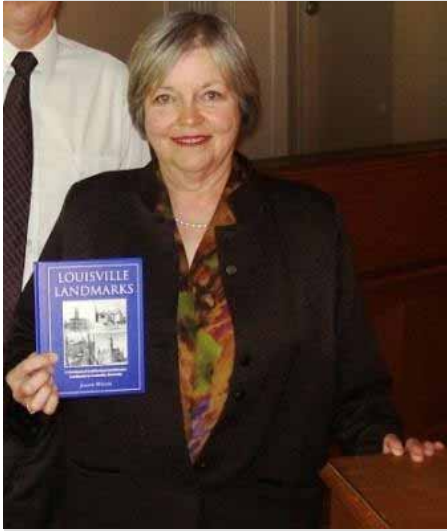


Louisville Historical League Photos
